## **Step 1 Choose your size**

We are currently offering a 40 inch diagonal with a 16 x 9 aspect ratio We are planning a 46 inch diagonal at a 16 x 9 aspect ratio to be added soon.



Our monitors have full high definition video resolution (1920 x 1080 p) and our videos currently range from 30 to 90 minutes per scene.

## **Step 2 Choose your frame style**

Wood trim is finished with a clear, hard, satin lacquer. The poplar is either uncoated for those who would like to apply their own stain, or primed for those who would like to paint it. Aluminum is provided with clear anodized finish.

Do not use samples to match other elements in a building (contact one of our designers).


# Step 4 Choose the Colors of the In-Wall Control & Speakers

The In-Wall Control has two parts, the Body and the Bezel trim. The Body comes in white or black.





The Bezel trim has seven finish options; white, ivory, almond, silver, black, brushed aluminum and black anodized aluminum.



The speakers are available in five standard finishes. These are; White, Gloss Black, Matte Black, Silver with Black grill, Silver with Silver grill and one optional finish of titanium.



The standard mount is a mounting trim that recesses the speaker in the wall or ceiling and this trim comes in an off white ABS plastic that can be painted to match your needs. Other mounting options are also available and can be discussed with a Sky Designer.

Surf, Rocks and Sand
Hawaii

Scene: es002 Duration: 33 minutes

- The setting sun illuminates sets of three to five foot curling waves, which break on the shore and foreground lava rocks.
- Wet sand exposed by receding waves reflects the golden sunlight.
- High clouds colored rose by the last light of the sun fade to gray.
- The sun disappears below the horizon (after eleven minutes).
- Daylight, reflected on the shore, waves and distant ocean, transitions into dusk.
- A distant surfer makes two cameo appearances.



Summer Alpine Brook Oregon

Scene: es009 Duration: 76 minutes

#### Scene es009

- High above tree-line, this July brook, which will disappear in August, is fed by melting snow.
- A moving cloud ceiling, only a few thousand feet above the land, produces changing patterns of light and shadow.
- The sound of the stream includes detailed notes of the foreground riffle.
- Although summer, at this altitude, the breezes are moving spring flowers.



SummerClouds High Desert Oregon

Scene: es010 Duration: 59 minutes

- A day in the life of sky above one of the world's most remarkable escarpments. This seven-hour segment noon to sunset — delivers a taste of life, just beneath the clouds of the Great Basin High Desert.
- The stately growth, dissolution and movement of summer clouds range from blue sky to threatening storm.
- The subtlety of the high altitude landscape is reveaLCD by the changing pattern of cloud shadows and sunlight.
- A sentinel Belding Ground Squirrel periodically climbs up into a foreground sage for his own view of the day (and the camera crew).
- Beneath the slowly transforming sky, the dominant experience is one of remoteness, purity and silence.



Summer Late Afternoon Pond Oregon

Scene: es015 Duration: 73 minutes

#### Scene es015

- The serene water, land and sky are rich with wildlife; egrets, pelicans, ducks, coots, grebes, herons, yellow-headed and red-winged black birds, muskrats.
- The background silence is punctuated by near and distant bird calls.
- In fact, the background silence is a high pitched hum of mosquitoes! You will see some too.



Tropical
Crashing Surf
Hawaii

Scene: es017 Duration: 48 minutes

- A cloudless blue sky.
- Three to four foot waves crash on a black lava rock shore at high tide.
- Wave sounds range from the deep bass of heavy crashes to the highs of ocean spray.
- On the horizon, Kilauea, Hawaii's active volcano, creates a plume where flowing lava meets the ocean.
- Black crabs and a fishing boat make cameo appearances.



Rain on Lake lowa

Scene: es025 Duration: 87 minutes

#### Scene es025

- Rain of varying strengths and patterns falls throughout most of the sequence.
- Changing wind directions and speed creates ripples and waves on the lake surface.
- Cloud-filtered sunlight creates dramatic shifts from dark to light.
- Low mist clouds are blown across the far end of the lake.
- Occasional bird songs can be heard through the sound of rain.
- · Occasional thunder.



Incoming Tide Maine

Scene: es027 Duration: 50 minutes

- Incoming morning tide washes drifting ocean kelps.
- Approaching waves pass beneath the observation point in the later portion of the sequence.
- 3 to 4 foot waves crash on the sandy beach and rocks.
- Seagulls and fish inside the waves occasionally appear.
